

ZASTARANJE: limitation vs. prescription

When used as **nouns**,

limitation means the act of limiting or the state of being limited; a time period after which some legal action may no longer be brought; whereas

prescription means the act of prescribing a rule, law, medicine, etc.. (*legal*): A time period after which some legal action may no longer be brought (*extinctive prescription* or *liberative prescription*).

A time period after which a person who has, in the role of an owner, uninterruptedly, peacefully, and publicly possessed another's property acquires the property (*acquisitive prescription*). The described process is known as *acquisition by prescription* (*priposestvovanje*) and *adverse possession*.
