Confidence refers to the [assurance](#) that we have on someone. **Trust**, on the other hand, refers to the firm [belief](#) that one has on another individual.

Faith is *a feeling, conviction, or belief that something is true or real, not contingent upon reason or justification. (Have **faith** that the criminal justice system will avenge the murder.)*

Reliance is the act of relying on someone or something; trust. (*In **reliance** on promises which proved to be of very little value.*)
