

ZAUSTAVITI: halt vs. stop

Halt suggests a stoppage in the midst of action. (*When you step on the brake **to halt** your car (verb), it comes to **a halt** (noun).*)

Halt means to **stop** either temporarily or permanently; to **bring to a stop**; to cause to **discontinue**.

Stop means to **cease moving**; to **not continue**; to cause (something) to cease moving or progressing; to cause (something) to **come to an end**; to **stay**; to **spend** a short time; to reside temporarily (*He **stopped** at his friend's house for two weeks.*)
