

ZAVEZA: commitment vs. pledge

Pledge and **commitment** both refer to something someone has agreed to do or promised to do. Essentially, both words refer to responsibilities. But these nouns describe different types of things that people agree to do.

Generally, a **commitment** involves time and responsibility, while

a **pledge** involves resources and money (*I pledged a million dollars to cancer research.*)

In both cases, something highly specific is being **guaranteed**. Someone might have a **commitment** to attend a meeting at a certain time, or complete a specific work project. (*Eco Pledges of COP26 included lowering global temperatures.*)
