

ZLAT: gold vs. golden

When used as **adjectives**,

gold means made of gold, having the colour of gold, something premium or superior; whereas **golden** means made of, or relating to, gold (*a golden crown/ring*); having a colour or other richness suggestive of gold (*under golden sun*); marked by prosperity, creativity etc. (*The Renaissance was a golden era.*); advantageous or very favourable (*This is a golden opportunity.*)
