

**ZVESTOBA:** (vdanost, predanost) adherence, allegiance, fidelity, fealty, loyalty, dedication, commitment, devotion

All these terms mean faithfulness to something to which one is bound by pledge or duty.

**Adherence** means steady or faithful attachment, **fidelity**. (*adherence to a political party*)

**Allegiance** suggests an adherence like that of citizens to their country. (*pledging allegiance*)

**Fidelity** implies strict and continuing faithfulness to an obligation, trust, or duty. (*marital fidelity*)

**Fealty** implies a fidelity acknowledged by the individual and as compelling as a sworn vow. (*fealty to the truth*)

**Commitment** means adherence to something to which one is bound by a pledge or duty (*his commitment to the political campaign*)

**Dedication** is self-sacrificing devotion and loyalty (*her dedication to the cause; the position required hard work and dedication*)

**Loyalty** implies a faithfulness that is steadfast in the face of any temptation to renounce, desert, or betray. (*He valued the loyalty of his friends*)

**Devotion** stresses zeal and service amounting to self-dedication. (*a painter's devotion to her art*)
